Event Instructions

Sign On

All riders must present a valid 2024 photo licence. Gear checks and equipment ratification should be done prior to signing on.

Youth B riders may only use cycles which conform with BC Technical Regulation 3.2.6. Wheels shall have a maximum rim depth of 35 mm, have minimum of 16 and a maximum of 40 spokes. Spokes can be round, flattened, or oval but must not exceed 10mm in width. Machines with dropped handlebars shall be used. Tri-bars, arm extensions and/or arm pads shall be prohibited.

All riders shall be subject to the maximum gear restrictions laid down under BC Technical Regulation 3.3.2: Youth A 6.93m, Youth B 6.45m. Gear checks shall be conducted both prior to and at random during each meeting for all categories. An official measuring jig shall be used to check all cycles at the National Final with regard to the use of tri bars by Youth A riders for 1km time trial.

Sign On opens at 8.30am for all categories and closes promptly at 9.30am. Please ensure that you have your bike checked and sign on as early as possible, Reserves should check back at 9.30 to confirm if they will be racing.

Reserves

Prior to the event any withdrawals allowing reserves to ride will be notified by email to riders concerned. Otherwise, reserve riders should sign on as normal but will only be notified prior to the start of racing whether they will be competing. Refunds will be given to reserves not able to compete.

Rider Instructions

Race Numbers

Each rider will be issued with two race numbers which should be positioned as indicated. **Race belts will not be allowed.**



Race transponders are not being used, timing is based on photo system so please ensure numbers are visible and not in any way blocked.

Time Trial

Heats will be run in numerical order with two riders per heat, odd numbered riders will start in the home straight and even numbered in the back straight.

Please ensure you are available to enter the track at the correct station well in advance of your heat.

In the event of a mechanical issue or crash at the start of a heat the affected rider should indicate this to the judges who will confirm if the race is to be restarted. The non affected rider should continue unless the starting pistol is fired.

Bunch Races

Riders should assemble on the left-hand side of the ramp prior to all bunch races.

Scratch Race

Distance 6 km (24 laps) for youth B, 10 km (40 laps) for Youth A.

Elimination Race

First lap free then one rider eliminated each lap. The bell will be rung when the last four riders cross the line with the 4th rider eliminated and the remaining three riders contesting the finish.

Keirin

The race will be run over 6 laps with the pacer pulling out with 2 laps remaining. Riders must maintain their drawn position behind the pacer for at least the first lap and must not go past the front wheel of the pacer until it has left the track.

Seeding is based on the omnium standings after the first three rounds.

Match B Keirin for 7th to 12th

Match C Keirin for 13th to 18th

Match D Keirin for 19th to 24th (plus 25th/26th if required)

Points structure

In the last match, where necessary, the 7th and 8th placed riders will receive 2 and 4 points less than the 6th placed rider respectively.

Points Race

Distance 36 laps for youth B with sprints every 6 laps, youth A will be 48 laps with sprints every 8 laps.

Only the top 24 placed riders in the Omnium Standings after the keirin/sprint competition are allowed to compete. In the case of a tie at this point the higher placed rider(s) in the keirin/sprint competition shall take preference.

The first four riders over the line each sprint will gain 5, 3, 2, 1 points respectively except for the final sprint on the last lap where points of 10, 6, 4 and 2 points respectively shall be awarded. Riders gaining a lap on the main field shall be awarded 10 points per lap gained. Riders losing a lap on the field shall be deducted 10 points per lap lost.

For the final event (the points race) the actual points attained by each rider in the race shall be added to their cumulative score for the first four events. Riders failing to finish the points race shall be awarded the same number of points as the last placed finishing rider. The rider with the highest cumulative points total shall be declared the winner. In cases of equal points, the placing of each rider in the final completed event run shall determine the final overall placing of those riders.
